What Temperature is a Fever?

Rectal	≥ 100.4
Under Arm/Tongue	≥ 100.0
Ear/Forehead Scan	≥ 100.0

Fever Severity

Low Fever	100 - 101.9
Med. Fever	102 - 103.4
High Fever	≥103.5

Note: DO NOT give your baby or child any Aspirin products.

Always consult your doctor if your baby (<3 months old) has any fever.

If your child's fever is ≥ 103, please schedule a visit with your doctor or call for advice after-hours (evening/weekend).

Acetaminophen (Tylenol®) every 4 hrs as needed
